The show contains projections via beamer or LED wall. We run the films ourselves. The sound is also connected to the films. Therefore our laptop needs to be connected to sound and beamer/ LED wall.

IMPORTANT: the light design must be done in a way it does not shine on the projections (except if there is a LED Wall.)

We need:

beamer

canvas or gaze or a nice wall

-3 x hand held wireless microphones on a stand

-monitor on stage

-connection laptop to beamer and sound

-follow spot and somebody to run it (we work a lot in the audience)

-Technicians in location for running light and sound cues.

-Steps from the platform to the audience in the middle of the stage

-One (private) cloakroom for the artists.

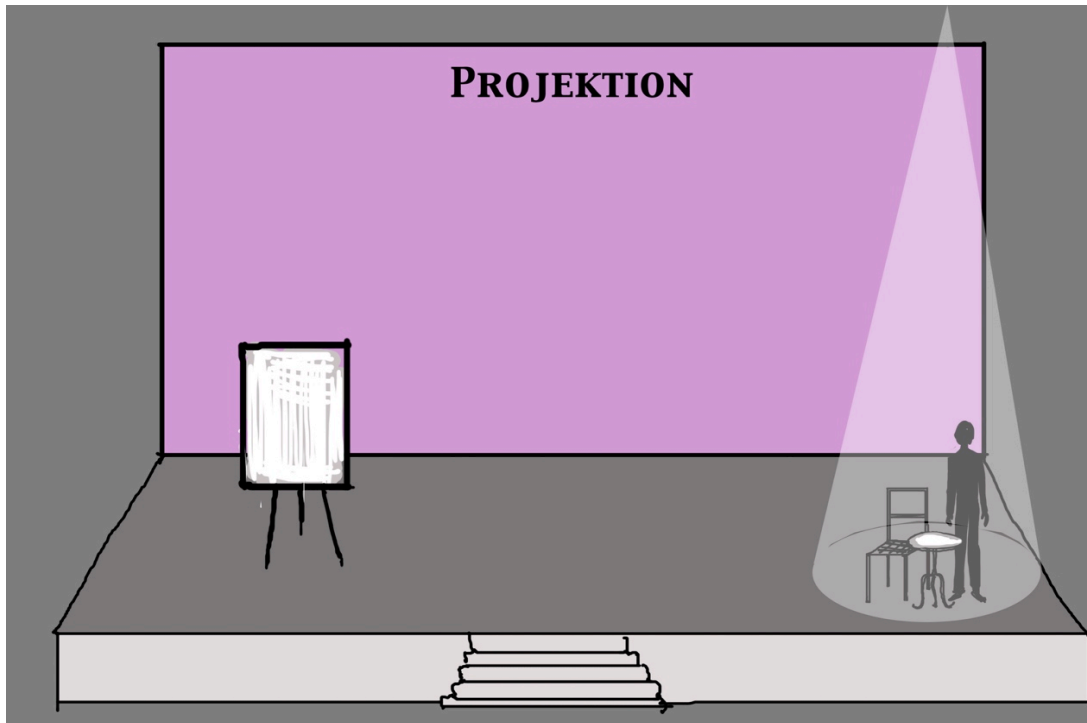
4 -5 hours for rehearsal.

LIGHT:

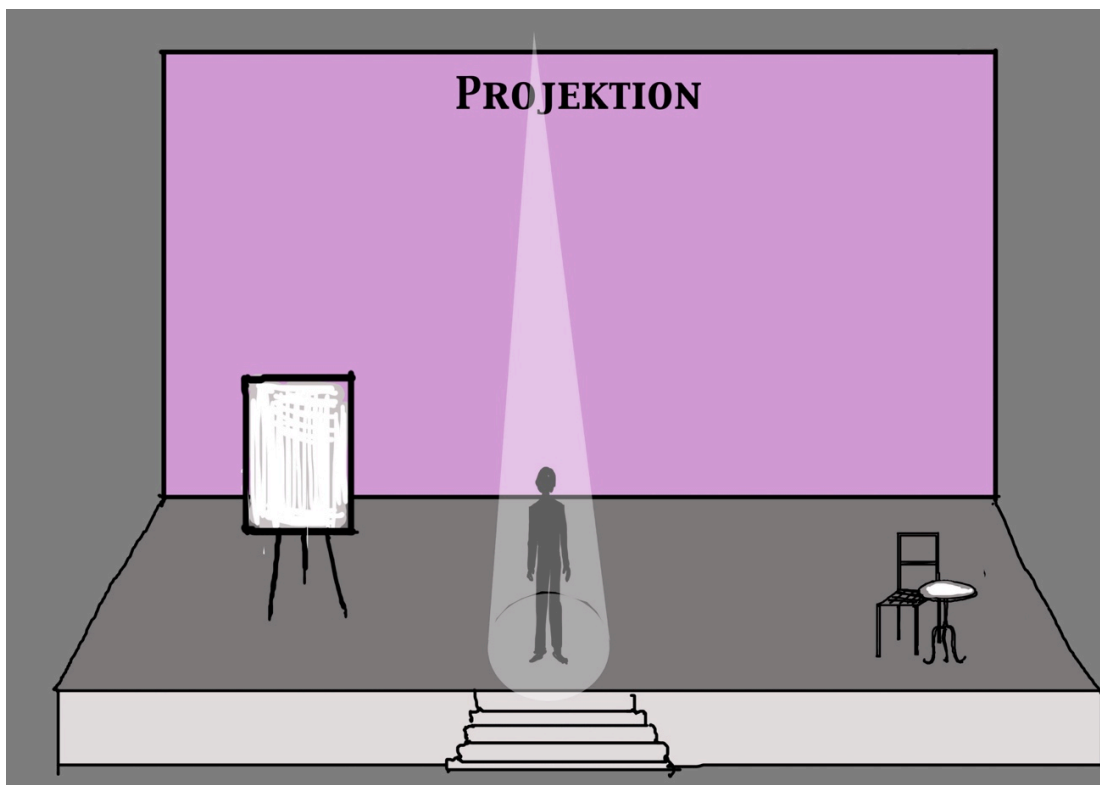
For better understanding you can see the light ideas we need (very simple):

(Please note: it seems the light comes only from top or back but surely we need also some light from the front).

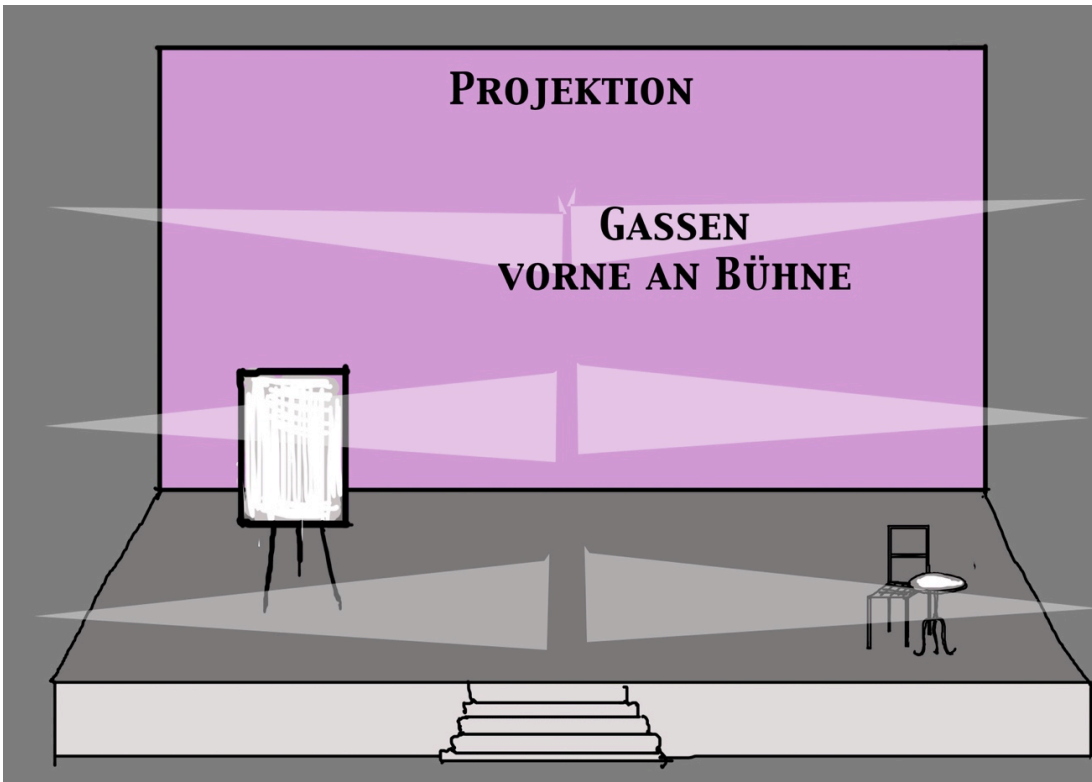
1.chair- light: small, intimate, mysterious.



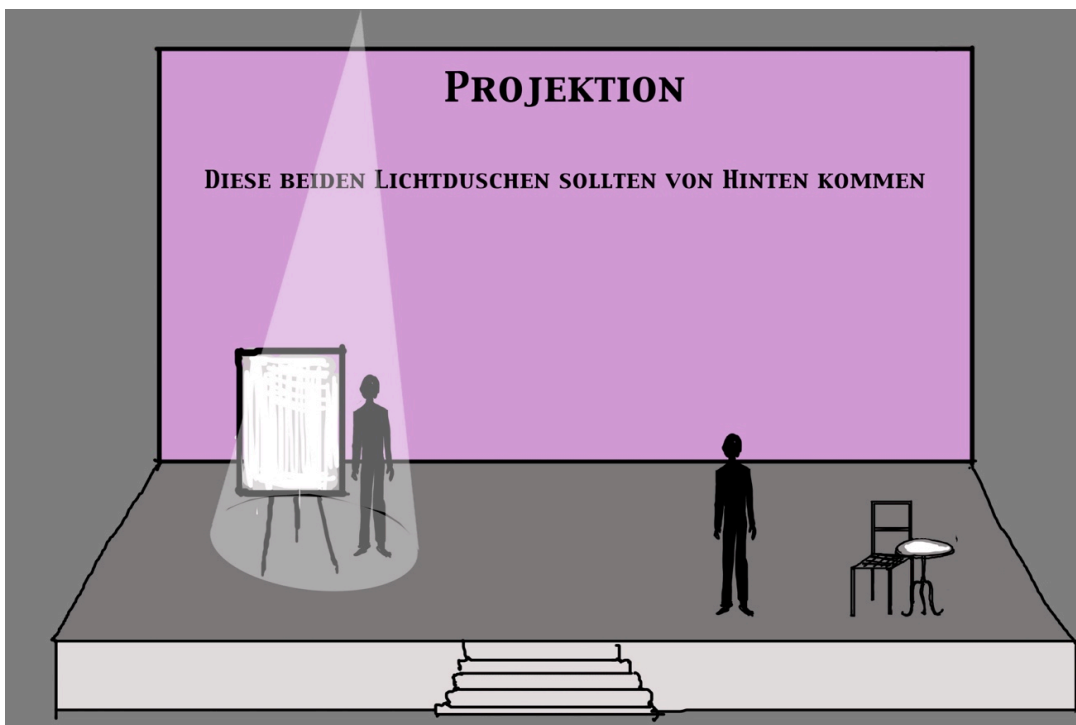
2. Marlene Dietrich- Light: white slim Spot from top- stage becomes small



3. side-light: in the front of the stage coming from top/ side or only side so the projections are not being disturbed. Colours: White und colours (like red, blue, magenta)

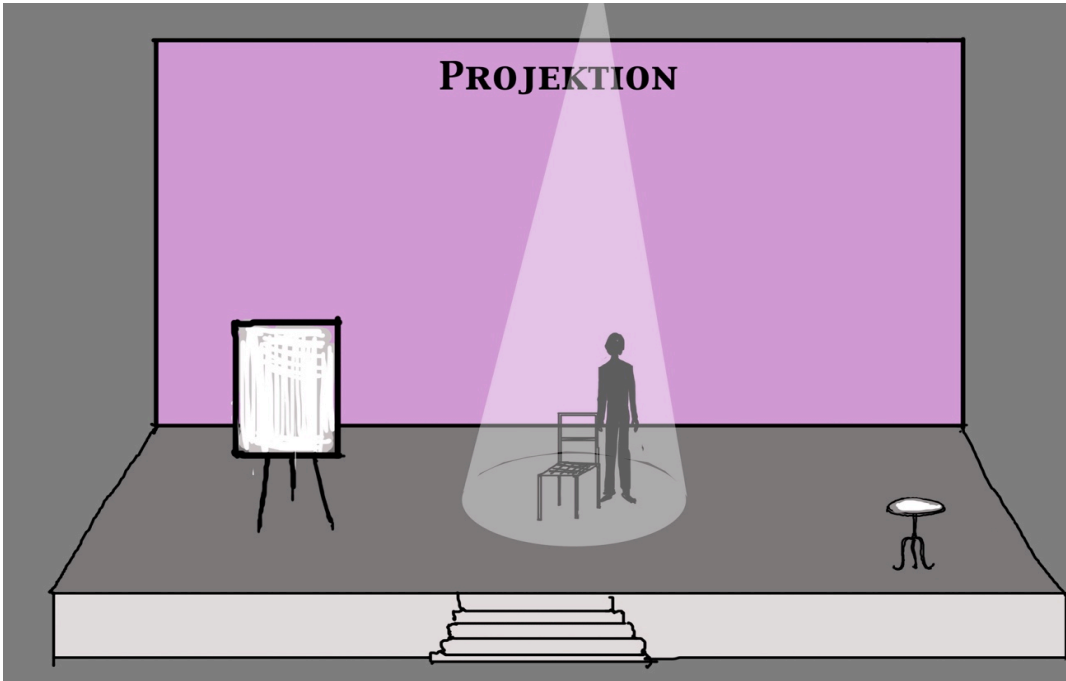


4. Easel- light: easel and person next to it must fit into it.

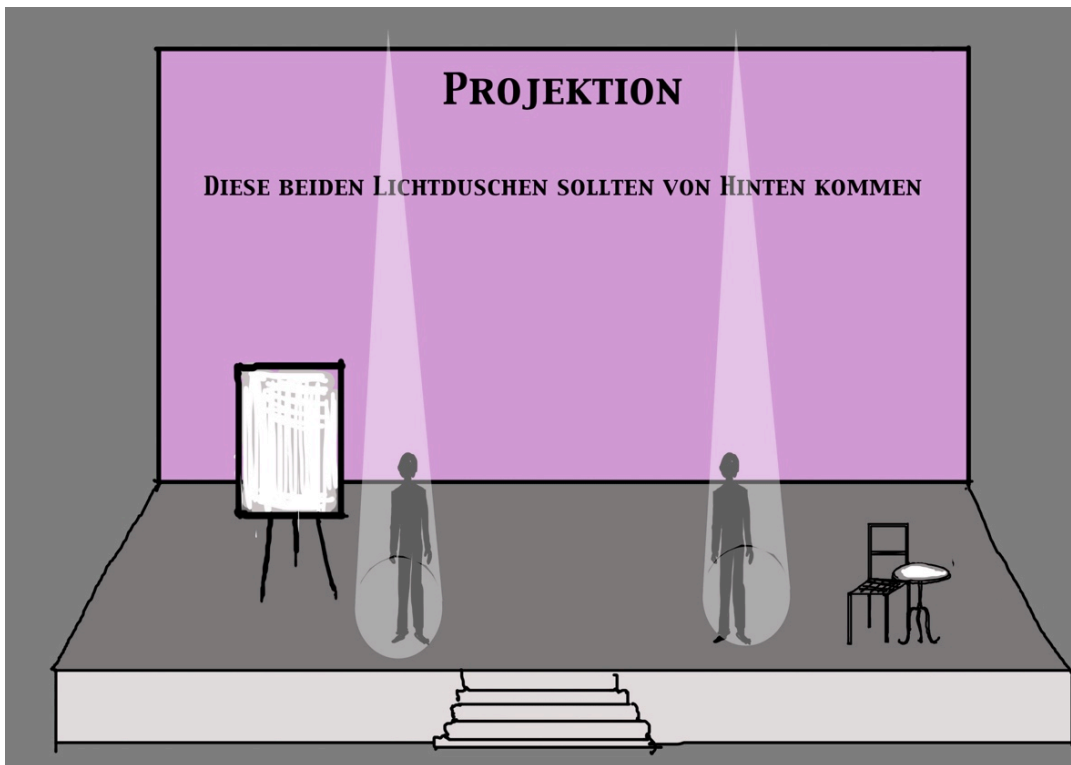


5. Chair

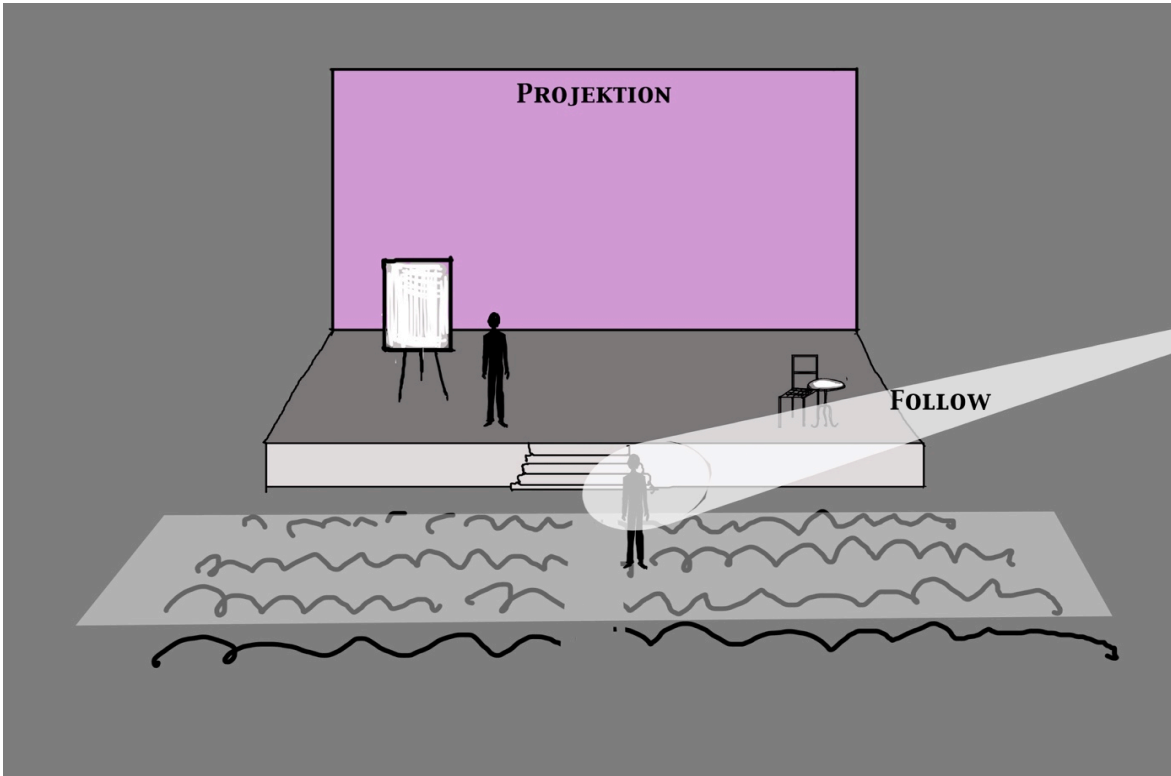
middle- light:
